# B. College repeat policy modification

Discussion:

- Last year AS&D (Advanced Standing and Degrees Committee) submitted a "College Repeat Policy" to EPC and Senate. Senate requested further information be gathered from the faculty regarding their feelings of the "repeat policy."
- A survey was offered to the faculty in October

Findings:

- Faculty split on students repeating courses
- GPA count for repeat courses /faculty approved current policy all grades are included in GPA
- Education Department concerns: State Board of Education will not approve certification for students receiving a C- in a required course
- Education Dept. is recommending an alternative course for student

- Hold student accountable with additional course
- Course repeat will require AS&D petition with faculty support
- No limit on repeat courses
- As an institution we can define what is an equivalent course to substitute
- State has recently defined grade of "C" as a 2.0
- All departments will be notified by the Education Department of the State requirements and recommendations to support students with alternative courses
